

**INNER-CITY EDUCATION PROGRAM
SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION
2008-2009**

The Inner-City Education Program provides scholarships for Chicago area junior high, high school or undergraduate college students seeking to receive a tuition-based education. To be eligible for a scholarship, the student must be actively playing ice hockey, demonstrate financial need; maintain a 2.0 grade point average on the standard 4.0 scale; possess a satisfactory discipline record, and demonstrate a strong personal character.

Each scholarship recipient and guardian must execute an undertaking, which will include a commitment to work or perform community service for a minimum of 80 hours during the summer prior to each and every scholarship year (and to verify such performance), and a commitment to authorize the release of relevant academic and behavioral records to the ICE Scholarship Committee.
